

IMPORTANT PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES (PwD) PROGRAM RESTRICTIONS

The Persons with Disabilities Program (PwD) has several restrictions in place to prevent duplication of transportation services. Some of the restrictions are:

1. If a pick up address is within $\frac{3}{4}$ mile of a SEPTA bus route and the destination address is within $\frac{3}{4}$ mile of a SEPTA bus route, the fare cannot be sponsored by the Persons with Disabilities (PwD) program, and the passenger is responsible for the full cost of the trip.
2. The Persons with Disabilities program will not fund transportation to any day programming services such as sheltered workshops, mental health day treatment centers, and adult training facilities. Trips to these addresses will not be sponsored by the Persons with Disabilities (PwD) program, and the passenger is responsible for the full cost of the trip.
3. If a passenger has Medical Assistance and it sponsors transportation costs, the Persons with Disabilities (PwD) program cannot be used to sponsor rides to medical appointments that are paid through a passenger's Medical Assistance. If the doctor does not accept Medical Assistance, the Persons with Disabilities program will fund transportation to that appointment.
